Additionally, the program requires that the deck cadets earn their U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) Third Mate License and Great Lakes Pilotage, and GLMA engine cadets earn their USCG Third Assistant Engineer licenses with both steam and motor endorsements. The following student achievement data is used to assess the GLMA program outcomes:

**Percentage of cadets that receive a satisfactory grade in license prep:** The goal of the GLMA program is to ensure cadets graduate with a license valid for service as an officer to serve on large tonnage vessels in the U.S. merchant fleet. Additionally, 46 U.S. Code 51506 requires that each state maritime academy (GLMA is a state maritime academy) require passing the USCG license a condition of graduation. Cadets must pass license prep (MDK 448 or MNG 496) before they are eligible to sit for

license exams
