**General Admission Criteria**

**Transfer Students**

- Combined college or university GPA of 2.35 (on a 4.0 scale) from all institutions. Students with a combined GPA of 2.35 or higher will not be considered in computing the GPA requirement.
- Transfer equivalency for FSU ENGL 150 or placement during the first semester at FSU which would require an ACT English score of 16 or higher; or SAT ERW score of 450 or higher; or Accuplacer English score of 6 or higher.
- Transfer equivalency for FSU MATH 150 or placement during the first semester at FSU which would require an ACT Math score of 19 or higher; SAT MATH of 500 or higher; or Accuplacer Math score of 4 or higher.
