

Articulation Agreement Between

**Northwestern Michigan College (NMC)
and
Ionia County Career Center**

The purpose of the program is to provide students with career and technical education (CTE) programs to the University of Michigan-Dearborn and Grand Valley State University. NMC will offer courses for the University of Michigan. NMC will also offer courses according to the community college requirements listed below.

Conditions/Requirements:

1. Student must enroll at NMC within 2 years of their high school graduation.
 2. Ionia County Career Center outcomes/competencies are reviewed regularly, ensuring curriculum alignment.
 3. Student completes the Culinary Arts class with a grade of B or better, demonstrating competency in all competencies to articulate the class.
 4. Student must send a letter of recommendation from their Ionia County Career Center instructor with their application.
 5. NMC instructor evaluates the Ionia County Career Center student learning based on the course objectives, course work, assessments and necessary documentation.
