3. NMC Instructor will evaluate the student's learning based on the course objectives, course

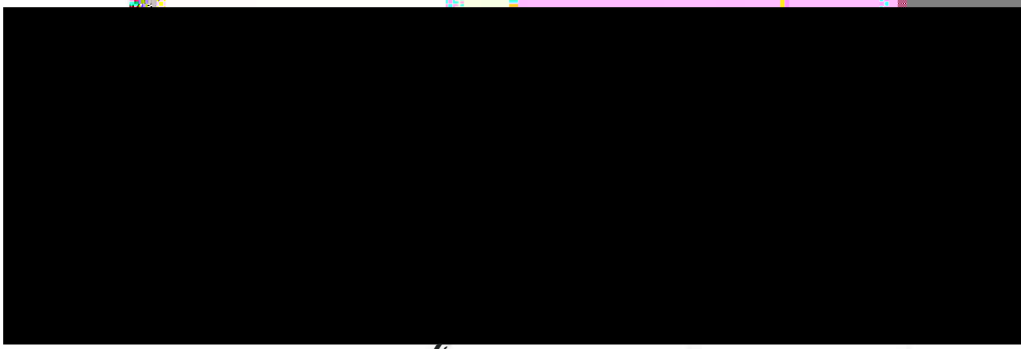
