### General Conditions and Requirements

1. Student must enroll at NMC and apply for articulated credit within two (2) years of their high school graduation date.
2. Student must enroll in a related program or similar program housed within the Technical Division at NMC for credits to apply to an associate degree or certificate.
3. Student must complete the first and second years of Northwest Ed classes with a grade of B or better and achieve the required competencies in particular the class.
4. NMC instructor will evaluate the student's learning based on the course objectives, coursework, and assessments and if necessary, an NMC written competency evaluation.

The following parties agree to abide by the terms and conditions of this agreement as outlined above. A designee from each institution shall be responsible for implementing this agreement, identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements, and for conducting a review every two (2) years.
