

Articulation Agreement
Northwestern Michigan College (NMC)
And
Northwest Ed Career Tech

The purpose of this agreement is to articulate the transfer of credit from Northwest Ed Career Tech to NMC. The college will award credit to students in the CJ program to the conditions and requirements listed below.

Conditions/Requirements:

1. Student must enroll at NMC and apply for articulated credit within two (2) years of their high school graduation date.
2. Student must enroll in a related program of study at NMC for credits to apply.
3. Student must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.
4. NMC instructor will evaluate the student's learning based on the program requirements and, if necessary, administer a competency evaluation.
