

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

And

Sienna Heights University and Northwestern Michigan College believe in the value of education for all people in their regions. It allows for the transfer of credits. Therefore, Sienna Heights University and Northwestern Michigan College are entering into the following agreement:

PRINCIPLES OF AGREEMENT

Sienna Heights University (hereafter known as Sienna) and Northwestern Michigan College – Technical Division (hereafter known as NMC) have formed this agreement to assure equal treatment of university students.

1. Sienna agrees that if a student satisfactorily completes the *Association of Applied Sciences Degree* from NMC, they are prepared for the four specific technical programs with appropriate transcript documentation.
 - a. When applied toward the completion of the *Bachelor's Degree*, an associate degree will be assumed as a junior or sophomore level standing. An appropriate person will determine if the student meets the requirements for the baccalaureate degree.
 - b. When Sienna have determined that the requirements for the baccalaureate degree have been completed.
2. No time limit (years) shall be placed on the acceptance of credits to Sienna university.
3. NMC students transferring to Sienna will receive equal class standing and access to other student services and funds.
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5. An informal review of programs will occur every two years for the purpose of determining enrollment and graduation data of each party's students and staff.
6. This agreement will automatically determine that a meeting is necessary to review and/or amend this agreement. Either institution may terminate this agreement at any time in advance of the effective date of termination. This agreement will be in effect for a five year period and may be renewed or extended by mutual agreement of the parties.
7. Upon formal approval of this agreement by the governing bodies of each institution, ongoing input, education and awareness will be developed by the appropriate representative at each institution. This will include communication to graduates and current students for recruitment into the program.
8. Each party shall be separately responsible for compliance with applicable laws, including nondiscrimination laws. The contract terms shall be subject to the provisions of the Michigan Handicap Accessible Act (1990) and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) as amended, being 42 U.S.C. 11911 et seq. and the Public Arts of 1974 as amended, being 36 U.S.C. 542101 et seq. and in violation of the provision that illegal discrimination by either party may be considered a breach of this agreement.

SIENA HEIGHTS UNIVERSITY GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

- Thirty (30) semester hours must be earned at Siena
- Thirty (30) semester hours (15) must be at Siena.
- The cumulative grade point average must be at 2.0 or better for the degree.
- Up to ninety (90) semester hours may be transferred from other institutions. This includes six (6) credits in general education credit earned within the degree program.
- Courses with the grade of (C) (2.0) and below will not transfer provided that grade was earned within a degree program at NHTI.
- Students must fulfill all Siena general arts requirements and must demonstrate proficiency in English and mathematics.
