General Conditions and Requirements

1. Student must enroll at NMC and apply for articulated credit within two (2) years of their high school graduation date.
2. Students must enroll in a related program of student (Engineering Technology, Manufacturing Technology, Welding Technology, Construction Technology, Automotive Technology or similar program housed within the Technical Division) at NMC for credits to apply to an associate degree or certificate.
3. Student must complete the first and second years of Wexford-Missaukee CTC Construction Technology class with a grade of B or better, achieve the required



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
