

MyAcademic Plan (MAP) Video Transcript

Welcome to MAP, My Academic Plan. MAP is a new online advising tool that will help you to understand your degree or certificate requirements, and track your progress towards completion.

You can access MAP on your myNMC page or in Self Service under Student Records.

Let's look at how MAP works.

Once you log in, the first thing you'll see on the worksheet is your personal information. It will include an Advisor if you are assigned and any holds you might have on your account. The worksheet also includes a list of requirements for your program, including general education requirements, and how many credits you need to complete these areas in order to graduate. The green checkmarks indicate areas that are met, and the red X's indicate areas that are not met. For example, you have completed 227 lab credits, but you still need 227 lab credits. If you have completed many credits in a particular area, you may see a green checkmark. If you have not completed any prerequisites for a course, you will see a red X.

As you scroll down the worksheet, you will see the requirements of your program, including general education requirements, and how many credits you need to complete these areas in order to graduate.

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
